

## **Extra Activities Weeks 3-4**

### **Overnight Car Camping**

In both weeks 3 and 4 there will be an overnight car camp to Mt Hood National Forest Wednesday-Thursday. We will be camping at Pine Point Campground on the shores of Timothy Lake, with views of Mt Hood. We will be hiking both days and can jump in the lake for a swim after hiking, in addition to setting up camp and cooking dinner together. We will head out for the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of hiking after making breakfast and breaking down camp. Campers will need to bring a tent (backpacking size or one to share). The White Salmon is a beautiful and federally designated wild and scenic river and we will be going with a guide and well known rafting company, Zoller's Outdoor Odysseys. Enjoy 1/2 day of fun on the water splashing and giggling down the river. No experience necessary! They supply all river clothing other than your base layer of shorts or swim suits. Unlike previous years this great trip is only about an hour away from camp. The cost will be \$75 and once a critical number have notified the leader that they are interested you will be given the directions to pay the company directly online. The trip will be in the morning allowing for a short walk or relaxing afternoon for your last day.
